d) Gillies Lake Garden Watering

MRCA purchased and tried a pressure washer, but it was not adequate for the garden needs. R. Whissell visited the garden and has offered to complete the electrical work to install a pump to draw water from the lake. A pump and attachments will need to be purchased at approximately \$400.00.

5.0 New Business

a) Fundraising Plan

A fundraising outline was presented to the membership by M. Lepage and J. Bonsall. The goal would be to raise \$197,000 to complete maintenance and upgrades to the community recreational trail system. The outline will be distributed to all members for their review. The plan requires a commitment of all members to participate in activities to take place over the course of one full calendar year, which will include development of information packages, social media posts, contacting potential donors, thanking donors, completing administrative tasks and more. A subcommittee will be required to move the project forward.

This is also an opportunity to look within the community for people who use the trails and might be willing to join Wintergreen, as we are looking for new members.

b) Bridge to Bridge Trail

L. Robichaud brought to everyone's attention that there is work being completed along the shoreline at Norman St. where the trail cuts in towards the river. D. Vallier noted the concern and will have the MRCA Field Supervisor take a look.

6.0 Parking Lot

a) Membership recruitment

Recruitment was discussed above with fundraising. R. Whissell reminded everyone of his offer of a booth at the Farmer's Market. Membership recruitment and Wintergreen promotion (trail maps, posters, checklists etc.) could take place over a few weekends. The fundraising campaign package could also be promoted later in the fall.

Action: Everyone try to think of new members. J. Bonsall will confirm dates with R. Whissell.

B. Torresan recommended becoming a member of the Timmins Chamber of Commerce as one of their non-profits. There are many resources available to members. M. Lepage volunteered to be the Wintergreen representative at the Chamber.

b) Wintergreen Paraphernalia

M. Joron noted that he has received several requests for litter pick-up sticks.
