
Timmins Flood Advisory Committee**NEWS RELEASE****FLOOD UPDATES****Mattagami River Watershed Flood Warning Extended****Other Areas Have Flood Watch Terminated**

Date of Issue— Wednesday, May 6, 2026

(Timmins, ON)— The Mattagami Region Conservation Authority (MRCA) and the Timmins Flood Advisory Committee continue to meet regularly to monitor local water levels and conditions. With limited recent precipitation, flood messaging for the Timmins area is being updated as follows:

The Flood Warning specific to the Mattagami River is being extended as snow melt continues across the watershed. Recent cooler temperatures have helped moderate the rate of snowmelt, however a significant volume of water continues to move through the Mattagami River system resulting in continued higher-than-normal water levels.

The Flood Watch for Porcupine Lake and River, Kamiskotia Lake and Town Creek has been terminated. High water levels from the spring melt have receded and are continuing to stabilize. While conditions have improved, residents are reminded that high water levels sometimes leave unstable banks and debris. Caution is always encouraged when near rivers, lakes and drainage channels, particularly for children.

Conditions can change quickly depending on the weather. The Committee will continue monitoring and will provide updates on a regular basis. For the latest public advisories, or to sign up for email flood notifications, please visit the MRCA website at www.mattagamiregion.ca
