WATER SAFETY – EXTENDED****SPRING MELT CONTINUES**

Date of Issue—Wednesday, May 4, 2022

(Timmins, ON)—The Timmins Flood Advisory Committee is reminding residents to use caution around waterways at this time of the year. With the warmer temperatures and the spring melt, there may be a water safety risk on waterways throughout the area. Local rivers, streams and flood channels will continue to experience fluctuations in water levels and flows.

City residents are cautioned against venturing out of lakes, rivers and small streams where slippery stream banks, thin ice, dangerous currents and fast-moving cold water will make waterways very hazardous. Parents are urged to warn children of these dangers.

The Flood Committee will continue to meet on a regular basis to review watershed conditions and forecasts. Further updates will be issued conditions change.
