**WATERSHED CONDITIONS STATEMENT EXTENDED  
FLOOD OUTLOOK: ALL AREAS**

**Higher than normal water levels continue**

**Date of Issue – Thursday, April 25, 2024**

**(Timmins, ON)**—The Timmins Flood Advisory Committee continues to meet to review up-to-date information regarding local water levels.

As a result, the current **Watershed Conditions Statement: Flood Outlook** has been extended. Water levels in the area continue to remain high and conditions can change quickly

City residents are once again cautioned against venturing out on lakes, rivers and small streams where slippery stream banks, dangerous currents and fast-moving cold water will make all waterways very hazardous. Parents especially, are urged to warn their children of these dangers.
